

ORDINANCE No. 2024-02

Parking Prohibited

STATE OF WISCONSIN

Town of Oneida
Outagamie County

The Town Board of the Town of Oneida, Outagamie County, Wisconsin, has the specific authority under s. 349.13, Wis. stats., to adopt this ordinance.

This ordinance, adopted by a majority of the town board on a roll call vote with a quorum present and voting and proper notice having been given, provides for the regulation of the stopping, standing, or parking of vehicles on town highways in the town as follows:

- A. The stopping, standing, or parking of vehicles on the following town highways in the Town of Oneida is subject to the following restrictions and limitations:
- a. East side of Lambie Road from Town Road to Fish Creek Rd
- B. The town chairperson, or his or her designee, shall place appropriate traffic signs on the above-described highways on or before the effective date of this ordinance.
- C. No persons may operate any vehicle on the above-noted town highways in violation of the above-noted stopping, standing, or parking restrictions and limitations. Any violation shall be subject to the penalty for violation of any provisions on this ordinance shall be a forfeiture of as hereinafter provided together with the costs of prosecution imposed as provided in ss. 345.20 to 345.53, Wisconsin Statutes.

This ordinance is effective on November 21, 2024.

The town clerk shall properly post or publish this ordinance as required under s. $\underline{60.80}$, Wis. stats.
